

There is a permission form that needs to be filled out and signed by a parent/guardian with completed contact info and emailed or postal mailed in. Poems and permission forms need to be received by the 25th of each month. Prize winners will be contacted by email.

**Prizes for the program:** (1) small box of popcorn and (1) small bag of candy and peanuts. The chosen poems will be displayed on the website.
